



PIP – a carbon neutral business

A key goal at Partners in Performance is to help reduce global carbon emissions.

Currently we emit around 2,600 tonnes of carbon each year, mainly through our use of air and car travel. To reach carbon neutrality we have reduced our energy use where possible and offset our remaining emissions.

We've moved our offices next to a bus and train terminal, and removed our car parking spaces to encourage our staff to use public transport. Where possible, we now set up teleconferences to reduce travel to meetings.

As well, we anticipate spending \$50,000 on emissions offsets with Climate Care. Climate Care invests in renewable energies and helps poor communities become more energy efficient and economically self-sufficient.
